Mary Rezny

My fine art: evolving and revolving

Mary S. Rezny is a photo-mixed media artist, based in Lexington, KY since 1976. Her studio in the Distillery District doubles as a gallery for her current art, as well as for that of established and emerging artists. Rezny is a 2009 Kentucky Foundation for Women grant recipient. Her work is exhibited regionally in galleries and juried exhibitions, and is included in the permanent collection of The Art Museum of the University of Kentucky. Her photographs have been included in two recent public art pro-

jects: she was one of two photographers chosen for the LexTran-LexArts 2009 public art display TransLucent in the

downtown transit center and in 2010, her work was selected for inclusion on Lexington's Legacy Trail.

This summer she was in a two person exhibition in Chicago's Logsdon 1909 Gallery "New Perspectives" and has been the official photographer for LexArts Horse Mania. Her next exhibit will be a three person exhibition in her studio/gallery "Present in Landscape" which opens Friday' September 17th during the city wide Gallery Hop.
