Sunrise & Sunset - competitively speaking - capture the orb's ascension toward full morning or descent toward darkness.



Astronomically speaking,

Sunrise is the instant at which the upper edge of the Sun appears above the horizon in the east. Sunrise should not be confused with dawn, which is the (variously defined) point at which the sky begins to lighten, some time before the sun itself appears, ending twilight. **Sunset** or sundown is the daily disappearance of the Sun below the horizon as a result of Earth's rotation. The time of sunset is defined in astronomy as the moment the trailing edge of the Sun's disk disappears below the horizon in the west.
