Working with the rangefinder camera and hand-held light meter gave Tom an appreciation for light and the technical aspects of photography. While studying architecture in at the University of Kentucky, Tom acquired a 35mm Nikon Nikkormat SLR and began a lifetime of landscape and architectural photography experimenting with a variety of cameras from pinhole boxes, medium format Hasselblad cameras, and large format 4x5 view cameras. Currently, Tom is working with a variety of digital SLR cameras, a 4/3 camera, a converted SLR infrared camera and

August 7 - DIY Workshop on Converting Negatives Do you have 100's or 1000's of negatives that you want to convert? Have you considered converting them yourself but don't know where to begin? Paul Briggs offers a hands-on workshop to show us how to efficiently convert our film negatives into quality digital images, using a scanner or digital camera. Please bring a digital camera or smart phone, and some sample negatives. If you have a laptop, please bring it too, as well as a means to transfer your camera images to your laptop. Paul will be using a photo editing program called PhotoLine and some plugins to convert the negatives; if you have Photoshop that will also work
