can also submit larger images, gallery wraps, or mixed media. Prints will be hung Saturday afternoon with 100% of sale proceeds going to the artist. We'll have sign up sheets at upcoming meetings. We are planning to have future showings at West 6th (4 per year) and they will have different themes.

Art at the Cathedral / Wonderful World

Print Deadline: TBD - Stay tuned!



The curator for Art at the Cathedral has invited us to exhibit once again this year as part of the July Gallery Hop. This year our theme is **Wonderful World** – it's fairly wide open and full of opportunity. We will limit the exhibit to a total of 50 prints, with no more than two submissions per artist. The exhibit is scheduled to be installed on July 6 and exhibited from July 13-Aug 25, with Gallery Hop on July 17 from 5-8. We will be refining

the drop off date and time and will publish that in June.

Prints do need to be framed with a secure wire for hanging, and covered with glass or plastic to protect your work. There is no size limit, but the Cathedral uses a hanging rod system that may not be able to accommodate very large prints. You may need to provide an easel to display oversized prints.

We will again be providing the food and libations for the multitudes at the July 17 Gallery Hop in exchange for access to this beautiful venue. Reports from past events indicate we have been received as a smashing success when hosting this Hop, so I am confident we will make another fine showing. We will be seeking volunteers in June to help with this part of the exhibit, so start collecting those recipes for fine finger foods and sweet snacks.

HomeLands, by Robb Hill, is a long-term photographic project that examines how



people create their self-identity from the land they live on and what happens when the connection to the land is severed.

Hill grew up just outside the town of Utica, Indiana. This area is now changing dramatically because of the I-265 extension.

The panoramic, black and white, landscape photographs of HomeLands are a meditation on the idea of home. By shaping the land people create their sense of self. When the bond between land and people is broken what happens to identity?

HomeLands will be on display in the Photographic Archives Gallery, in Ekstrom Library, from March 12 through May 22. The gallery is open from 8 a.m. - 5 p.m., Monday - Friday. The Ekstrom Library is located at 2215 S. 3rd St. in Louisville.
