About those 2015 dues payments . . .

Due to our print show being scheduled in January of 2015 we will be unable to collect 2015 club dues in the usual manner at the regular January meeting.

Dues will be accepted at the print show judging on January 8th. If you are planning on paying your dues at that meeting your payment will be subject to the following conditions.

• All dues payments must be accompanied by a COMPLETED 2015 Registration Form. This form is available under "Archives-Club Forms-Other Documents" on the club website, www.creativecameraclub.org. Blank registration forms WILL NOT be available at the meeting.

• Your payment, in the form of a check or CASH FOR THE EXACT AMOUNT of your dues payment must accompany your completed registration form. Change for cash payments will not be available at the judging.

• Please paper clip or staple your payment to your registration form to avoid loss, and deliver your payment to Don Mills, our club Treasurer, at the January meeting.

Keep in mind that mail-in payments are more than welcome at the address indicated on the bottom of the registration form.

Again, you will not be permitted to enter the February monthly competition unless your 2015 dues are paid.
