2021 Blue Ridge Parkway Trip June 10th-13th

Our 2021 Blue Ridge Parkway trip is scheduled for June 10th-13th. The time of this year's trip has been moved up from its usual end-of-July time frame in order to take advantage of the rhododendron and flame azaleas that will typically be blooming along the parkway at that time of year. Other seasonal wildflowers we don't typically see on our trips will be blooming at that time. We're also adding more recommended shooting locations to the list, in order to provide some variety from the trips we've done previously.

A block of 20 rooms has been reserved at Maggie Valley Creekside Lodge at a special camera club rate. Unsold rooms will be released by May 10th. A room with two queen beds will be \$99/night after the club discount is applied. Feel free to go ahead and reserve a room by calling 1-800-621-1260.
