Creative Camera Club (CCC) member John Snell will take the club on a run-through of his 2021 photographic journey. Destinations include Red River Gorge, Blue Ridge Parkway/Smokies, Colorado, Florida and a couple of other venues in Kentucky. The presentation will include photo how-to tips, as well as locations and thought processes leading to the capture of many of the images. He'll conclude with a collection of his top ten favorite photos from 2021.

John has been a member of the CCC since 1989 and has served on its board almost continuously. Dubbed "Mr. Fieldtrip" by former club president, Bob Johnson, John has led the club on summer outings since 1994 to Big South Fork, Red River Gorge, West Virginia, the Smokies, and almost annually since 2005, the Blue Ridge Parkway area of North Carolina. He has been named the club's Advanced Color Photographer of the Year five times.


NANPA Virtual Summit

2022 Blue Ridge Parkway Trip, June 9th-12th

After a very successful trip last year (34 attendees!), the 2022 Blue Ridge Parkway trip is scheduled for June 9th-12th. The time of this year's trip has once again been chosen in hopes of taking advantage of the rhododendron and flame azaleas that will typically be blooming along the parkway at that time of year. Other seasonal wildflowers we don't typically see on our trips will be blooming at that time. Typically, the large number of waterfalls in the area will be gushing forth. And there are numerous vistas from which to

capture landscape, sunrise and sunset photos.

A block of 20 rooms has been reserved at Maggie Valley Creekside Lodge at a special camera club rate. Unsold rooms will be released by May 9th. Feel free to go ahead and reserve a room by calling 1-800-621-1260. You may have to leave a message, but they'll usually call you back within 24 hours. Be sure to tell them you're with the Creative Camera Club, in order to receive the discounted rate. Other room configurations are available (King Bed with Jacuzzi, etc.) as well, and all will receive similar discounts. All rooms have a refrigerator, microwave and wi-fi.
