The Club Guidelines and Rules pertaining to monthly meetin competitions: Meeting competition categories shall be selected from a survey of the membership.


A possible addition to the rule above, but not actually presented in a motion or discussed in complete detail was the following - Pictures selected for competition shall not be limited to any date on which they were taken.

2024 Blue Ridge Parkway Date Change

At the conclusion of our 2023 BRP trip, I checked out of the Maggie Valley Creekside Lodge before the office opened. Therefore, I didn't get to confirm with Carol Burrell, the manager of the hotel, that we wanted to reserve rooms for the second weekend of June (June 6-9) for 2024. The day after I checked out of the hotel, a motorcycle group booked most of the rooms for June 6-9, 2024, leaving us with only a few of the 2nd floor noncreekside rooms for June 6-9, 2024.
